


The Underlying Philosophy



Educare

Right from its inception, Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning has integrated ethics and values as the undercurrent of every subject taught at the university. Combined with academic excellence, the university provides a holistic framework of inter-personal development for its students.

Its compulsory residential character trains the mind, body and spirit of the student in an environment similar to the ancient Indian 'gurukula' system of education, in the most modern context.

The university strives at every level to blend the Academic (Secular) aspects of learning with that of Character Building (Spiritual), as depicted in the 'Temple of Learning' diagram.

This helps students develop a wholesome and balanced personality, one where academic competence is supplemented with good character.


The National Education Policy document echoes this thought:

"The rich heritage of ancient and eternal Indian knowledge and thought has been a guiding light for this Policy. The pursuit of knowledge (Inan), wisdom (Pragyaa), and truth (Sathya) was always considered in Indian thought and philosophy as the highest human goal. The aim of education in ancient India was not just the acquisition of knowledge as preparation for life in this world, or life beyond schooling, but for the complete realization and liberation of the Self."



Sri Sathya Sai Baba very succinctly defines spirituality as removal of animal qualities, nurturing of human qualities and manifesting the divine qualities in human beings. This process of bringing forth from within the latent divine qualities is defined by Baba as Educare. Educare, indeed, is the very essence of this Institute.

Sri Sathya Sai Values-based Integral Education


Sri Sathya Sai Values-based Integral Education is a modern, rational, scientific education system rooted in Indian ethos. It takes the best of both ancient and contemporary learning techniques.

As depicted in the diagram, the base is the concept of a modern Gurukula that sustains all relationships and activities at SSSIHL. It is responsible for creating and sustaining the congenial environment necessary for the teacher-student interaction to grow and develop.

Adherence to discipline and appropriate behaviour are the two important aspects that encompass all interactions. The five human values of Truth, Right Conduct, Peace, Love and Nonviolence form the undercurrent of the integral education's dimensions.

The key activities for each of the five dimensions - Intellectual, Physical, Cultural, Devotional and Service - form the basis of most of a student's time at SSSIHI.

Bhagawan Baba has designed the system of Sri Sathya Sai Values-based Integral Education in such a manner that between the time an 18-year old student joins the university and when she or he graduates (at the age of 21 or 23) there is a deep inner transformation that takes place. This concept is very unique at the university level.



All students at SSSIHL spend 60% of their time (on average) at university on intellectual activities (primarily on their studies).

The rest (40%) is spent almost equally on activities related to the Integral education dimensions of Devotional, Cultural, Physical and Service.


The outcomes of the system of Valuesbased Integral Education at SSSIHL are fivefold. It prepares all graduates to be:














Research Philosophy











































Devotional Dimension

Creates avenues for expression of a student's creative potential through various art forms and helps develop an appreciation of the different facets of culture












