



XL Annual Convocation 22 November 2021

CIRCULAR

The XL Annual Convocation of Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Prasanthi Nilayam will be held on 22 November 2021.

The list of Registered Candidates for the Convocation is stated separately on the Institute website.

In view of the Covid19 pandemic, the Convocation this year will be held in blended mode. Those who have registered In-Person will attend personally while those who have registered In-Absentia can attend virtually. The live telecast of the event will be made on the Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning Official Youtube Channel on 22nd November. The timing and venue of the function shall be announced in due course.

All Graduating students registered for the convocation **In-Person** will need to make their arrangements for stay and dining outside the Prasanthi Nilayam premises. Further they should get themselves vaccinated, both doses, by October 31, 2021 and carry their vaccination certificates downloaded from [cowin.gov.in](https://www.cowin.gov.in) on the day of Convocation. They can contact their concerned Campus Director at Prasanthi Nilayam, on arrival, for further instructions.

Dress Code for the Convocation : Women candidates : White Saree and White Blouse

Men candidates : White Kurta and White Pyjama.

Normal Covid protocol of wearing masks, maintaining social distancing and use of sanitizer should be adhered to.

All students who have registered for convocation (**In-Absentia**) will be sent their degree by Insured parcel post. Please note that

- a) Candidates are required to send a self-addressed, stamped, water-proof envelope to Controller of Examinations, SSSIHL, Administrative Building, Prasanthi Nilayam – 515 134. The university requires this in order to send the degree certificates back to the candidates by post.
- b) The envelope should state clearly name and programme of student.
- c) The envelope must be 16x12 inches in size. The full and complete postal address must be clearly written or typed on it, including the town/city, PIN code, district and state. Lastly, stamps totalling ₹48 must be affixed on the top right-hand corner of the envelope. Students of foreign nationality may send a mail to the Controller of Examinations in this regard before sending the self-addressed envelope.
- d) Degree certificates will be despatched by post (in the submitted envelope) to candidates after the Convocation.
