## **INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES**

- I. The filled in application form must be sent by <u>Registered Post</u> to: The Controller of Examinations, Administrative Building, Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Prasanthi Nilayam – 515134, Sri Sathya Sai Dist., Andhra Pradesh.
- II. Kindly mention the word 'Convocation' on the envelope for the university's easy reference.
- III. No Registration Fee is charged for the convocation.
- IV. Once the application is submitted (by hand or post), candidates are required to send an email to convocation@sssihl.edu.in from the same email-id filled in the form (Item #6). The email must include their Name, Regd. No. and the Name of the Degree for which the application is made and request an acknowledgement receipt of the form. The University will respond to the email within 15 days, failing which, the candidate is requested to resend the email.

Note: All correspondence regarding the convocation with the University will only be via email: <u>convocation@sssihl.edu.in</u>

- V. Starting the 3rd week of August, the university will publish the list of candidates accepted for the 2022 Annual Convocation. This list will be periodically updated till September 05, 2022 and will be accessible from the home page of the university's website: <u>www.sssihl.edu.in</u>.
- VI. Nearer to the date of the convocation, registered candidates will then be required to download the Circular published on the website and follow the instructions therein.

Note: The circular will not be emailed to candidates.

- VII. a) No column in the form must be left blank. Kindly enter 'NIL' for items that are not applicable.
  - b) Incomplete applications will be rejected. No correspondence will be made on this matter.
- VIII The Name of the candidate that will finally appear on the degree certificate (including initials, spelling and splitting up of names) will be exactly as per the Qualifying Certificate submitted (Item #8). Kindly ensure that this name is substantially the same in your Aadhar Card (for Indian citizens).
- IX. Candidates opting for 'IN ABSENTIA' only:
  - a) Candidates are required to send a self-addressed, stamped, waterproof envelope. The university requires this in order to send the degree certificates back to the candidates by post.
  - b) The Envelope should state clearly name and programme of student.
  - c) The envelope must be 16x12 inches in size. The full and complete postal address must be clearly written or typed on it, including the town/city, PIN code, district and state. Lastly, stamps totalling ₹48 must be affixed on the top right-hand corner of the envelope. Students of foreign nationality may affix appropriate postage for an envelope weighing 100-120 gms.
  - d) Degree certificates will be despatched by post (in the submitted envelope) to candidates during the second week of December, after the Convocation.
- X. a) Candidates applying for admission to the convocation for undergraduate degrees such as B.A. / B.A. (Hons.) / B.Sc. / B.Sc. (Hons.) / B.Com. (Hons.) / B.B.M. / B.B.A. and B.C.A. should enclose only the photocopy of the original pass certificate of Intermediate or Pre-University issued by the Board.
  - b) Candidates applying for admission to the convocation for **postgraduate** degrees such as M.A. / M.Sc. / M.B.A. / M.B.A. (Fin.) / M.F.M. / M.Tech. / B.Ed. / M.Ed. should enclose only the **photocopy** of the Original Degree Certificate of the **gualifying degree** issued by the **University**.
  - c) Candidates applying for admission to the convocation for the M.Phil. / Ph.D. programme should enclose only the **photocopy** of the Original Post Graduation Degree Certificate issued by the **University.**
  - d) <u>Please do not enclose photocopies of Semester Grade Cards</u>, <u>or Consolidated Grade Card</u>, <u>or Provisional Degree Certificate</u>.

All students may kindly note that Provisional Certificates are valid only till the Convocation of the year in which they were issued. Post Convocation, only original Degree Certificates issued at the Convocation will be validated by the University.

## XI. NATIONAL DEPOSITARY SERVICE BY GOVERNMENT OF INDIA FOR ALL UNIVERSITY STUDENTS.

Students registering for convocation 2022 are hereby informed that as per the mandate of University Grants Commission, India, the degree certificates of the university will be uploaded on the National Academic Depository UGC – NAD Digilocker after the Convocation on November 22, 2022. The degree certificates may be accessed from Digilocker website from January 01, 2023 onwards.

Students of Indian Nationality may visit Digilocker website (https://digilocker.gov.in) or download mobile app (android and ios) and sign up with mobile number or Aadhar number.

The Digilocker website will provide the service of authentication of degree certificates free of charge to students and any other person or institution duly permitted by the student in future. Students are encouraged to avail of this national service.

The modalities of this service being available to foreign students who do not have Aadhar card / Indian mobile number are being worked out by Digilocker and the service may be available in a few months time.

It may be noted that the above service is in addition to the degree certificate authentication being done by the Institute by Registrar, Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning.

It may also be noted that once the convocation of the year is over, the Institute will cease to authenticate provisional degree certificates issued and will certify only degree certificates. Hence, registration for any year's convocation (either in person/in absentia) is essential to avail the degree certificate from the Institute. It is also essential to avail of the Digilocker service.
