Macro Stabilization Policies for India during the Post Pandemic Period

26th August 2023

The COVID-19 pandemic engraved an unprecedented economic situation in the world economy and India was no exception. According to the National Statistical Office (NSO), India's GDP contracted by 24.4% in Q1 of the fiscal year 2020-2021, and shrank by 7.3% in the entire fiscal year, the first fiscal contraction in over four decades. India faced multi-faced challenges of economic revival, job creation, livelihood restoration, and solid healthcare infrastructure to penetrate vaccine drives. The pandemic underscored immediate social security nets with sustainable and inclusive economic policies.

What happened to the economy post-crisis? What other roles did fiscal and monetary policies play? How did initiatives like *Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan*, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), and master plans like *Pradhan Mantri Gati Shakti Yojana* come to the limelight? How did fiscal stimulus packages and the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) accommodative stance respond to the economy? The Department of Humanities and Social Sciences is organizing a national workshop themed "Macro Stabilization Policies for India During the Post-Pandemic Period" to seek answers to similar questions and discuss further on the theme.

The workshop will comprise of Special invited lectures by **Prof. N R Bhanumurthy**, the Vice-Chancellor of Dr. B R Ambedkar School of Economics University, **Dr. Deba Prasad Rath**, Principal Adviser, Department of Economic Policy and Research (DEPR) at Reserve Bank of India (RBI), and **Dr. Nadhanael G.V**, Director of the Division of Reports and Knowledge Dissemination, DEPR, RBI. The last special invited lecture in the workshop will be delivered by **Prof. Ashima Goyal**, a distinguished member of the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) and an emeritus professor at India Gandhi Institute of Development Research (IGIDR). The program will also comprise of student presentations from the department.

This workshop is aimed to serve as a platform for students, scholars, faculties, and policymakers to engage in meaningful discussion on stabilization measures post pandemic period. The workshop is expected to be fruitful in understanding the complex economic landscape of India and further inspire thoughtful policy considerations.
