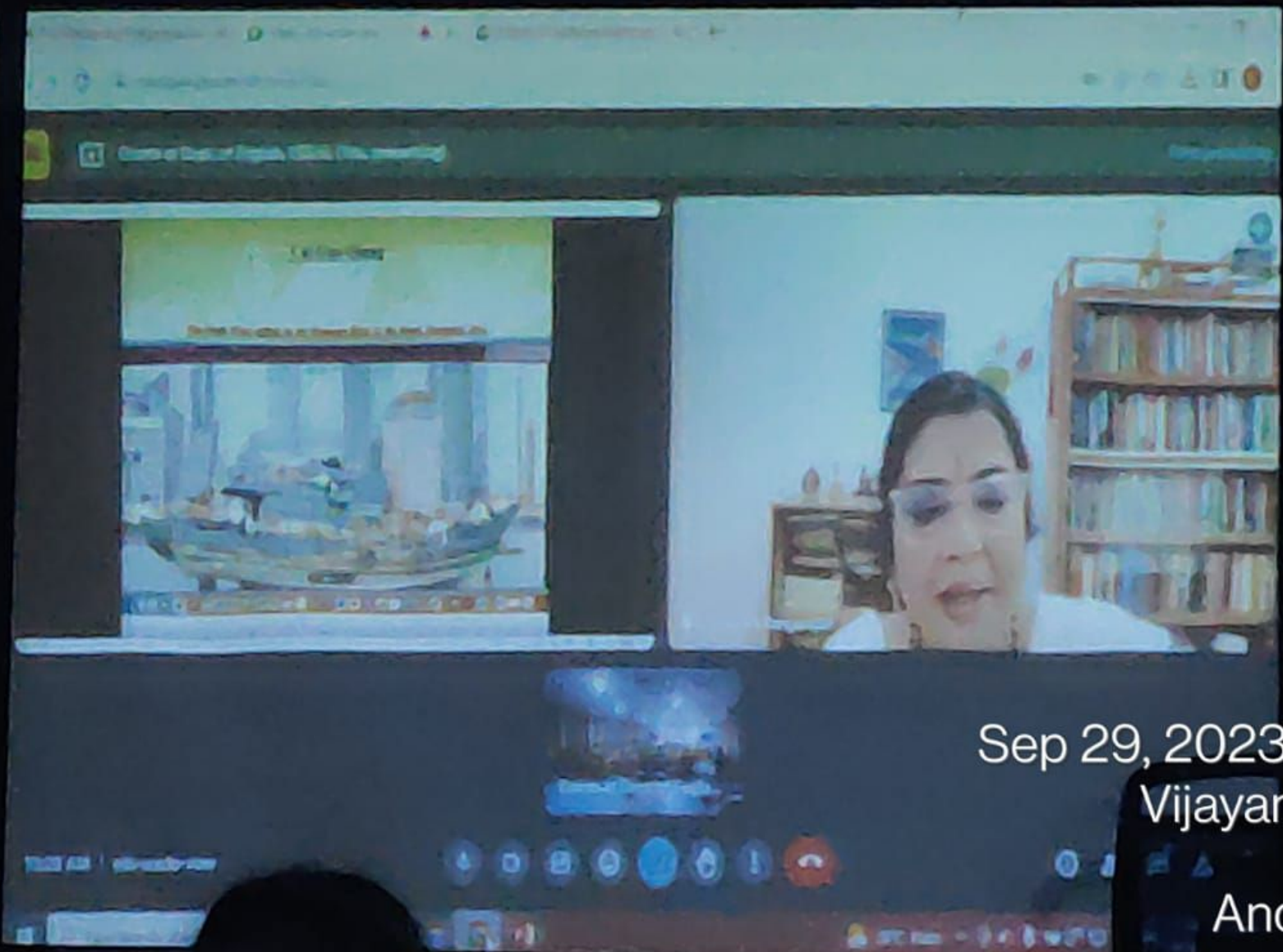

- Women were the propagators of civilisation, not primarily in the sense of propagating human population, but as the preservers and propagators of culture. – C. Subramania Bharati
- Key moments in history- 1970 Chipko Movement to the recent UNEP summits Chipko movement- led by women like Gaura Devi, Sundari Devi, and Chandi Prasad Bhatt, not only saved forests but also ignited a global environmental consciousness.
- The 1992 Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro- Indigenous women played a crucial role in shaping the summit's agenda.
- In 1995, at the Beijing Conference on Women- indigenous women from around the globe gathered to amplify their voices and made it clear that environmental issues were intrinsically linked to women's rights.
- The Green Belt Movement, the conservation and forestry movement which originated in Kenya on Earth Day in 1977, is another famous effort initiated by women.
- 2002 World Summit in Johannesburg, South Africa- indigenous women as a force for change. They highlighted the devastating impact of climate change on their communities and the urgent need for adaptation and mitigation measures.
