25th – 29th October 2023 About the FDP

Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, (DHSS), Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Learning, Pransanthi Nilayam, is organizing a 5-day Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on "Academic Ethics, Scientific Writing and Unit-Level Data" from October 25th – 29th, 2023. This FDP will be delivered in two significant segments that are of great relevance in the present social science research domain. In the first segment, participants will be guided on topics like ethics in academic communication, scientific writing and techniques of research publication followed by issues in secondary research. The participants will also be enlightened on the elements of survey research.

In the second segment, the scholars will be introduced to various large-scale survey datasets like NFHS, IHDS and NSSO that are freely available on public platforms. Then, the FDP will specifically train the researchers to handle large-scale complex health survey dataset (i.e. NFHS) for detailed analysis. It will cover obtaining the publicly available NFHS dataset, manage the data, and conduct basic data analysis to draw useful insights. Widely used statistical software Stata will be used for data management and data analysis. The FDP will train participants in importing NFHS data to Stata, data management, data manipulation, reshaping datasets, introduction to svyset and regression analysis.
